

IMPORTANT:  
PLEASE READ BEFORE UPGRADING  
**YOUR PC-Duo Server**  
to Version 12.7 hotfix#6 (or later)  
or Version 12.6 hotfix#5 (or later)

In order to enhance security and compliance with industry best practices, the PC-Duo Gateway Server now restricts SSL connections to TLS v1.2 only. This limits backwards compatibility with earlier versions of PC-Duo software when connecting to the Gateway via SSL or WSS only.

Note that TCP and UDP connections are NOT affected by this change.

Any Host or Master will need to be upgraded to at least the latest hotfix for its version or it will no longer be able to connect to the Gateway over SSL or WSS. The specific versions and hotfixes that should be upgraded are:

- PC-Duo v12.1, any version prior to v12.1.2060 hotfix#4 (released February 2015).

Versions going back further (v11.0 through v12.0) do not support TLS v1.2 at all. Connections would need to be made using UDP or TCP in order to keep using these versions.
